

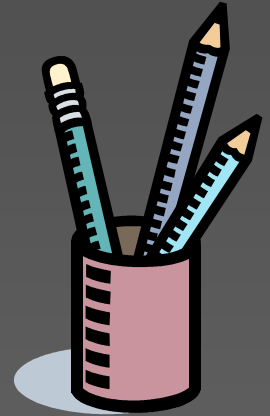

# RHS Graduation Requirements

<b>Subject Area</b>	<b>Credits (10 credits = 1 year)</b>
<b>Language Arts</b>	<b>40 credits</b>
<b>Social Studies</b>	<b>35 credits</b>
<b>Mathematics</b>	<b>30 credits</b>
<b>Science</b>	<b>30 credits</b>
<b>PE</b>	<b>30 credits</b>
<b>Health</b>	<b>5 credits</b>
<b>Technology</b>	<b>10 credits</b>
<b>Visual &amp; Performing Art</b>	<b>10 credits</b>
<b>World Language</b>	<b>10 credits</b>
<b>Electives</b>	<b>50 credits</b>

# Credit Recovery

- Credit Recovery for courses needed to fulfill graduation requirements.
- Summer school registration forms will be available in April. (June 18<sup>th</sup> – July 13<sup>th</sup>)
- Two sessions (am/pm) – each session is one semester credit per class.
- Four weeks = C grade
- Night School is available fall & spring semester (11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> grades ONLY)
- Night School classes do NOT fulfill four year college eligibility requirements.



# Community Service



- 25 hours required for RHS graduation
- Non-Profit agency or organization
- Opportunities and contracts available in the College & Career Center.
- All hours MUST be submitted within the school year that hours are completed.
- Community Service hours should be completed by the end of the Junior Year.
- Distinguished Community Service Award given for 150 more hours of service!

- > Students will complete course requests for junior year through Aeries Student Portal.
- > Student Portal to select courses will close at 11:59pm on February 16<sup>th</sup>.

# Advanced Placement Courses

- College Level Curriculum – weighted GPA
- Check pre-requisites & plan accordingly
- AP Exams are administered in May – approximately \$95-\$100 per exam.
- Counseling Dept. recommends no more than 3 advanced courses per year.
- Students may receive college credit based on AP exam score:

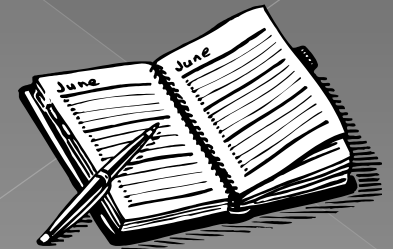
# Planning for Course Registration

- Review courses in Academic Planning Guide (found on front page of school website under “Announcements”)
  - > Read course descriptions thoroughly.
  - > Check pre-requisites for all courses.
- Discuss options with current teachers to gather input and recommendations.
- Complete Course Selection form and Adv/Honors/AP form if applicable.
- Balance courses over 11<sup>th</sup>/12<sup>th</sup> grade!

# Course Request Confirmation Process

## ⦿ Week of March 5<sup>th</sup> – March 9<sup>th</sup>

- > Students must have Course Planning form with parent signature on Mon. March 5<sup>th</sup>!
- > Students will be released during Language Arts class to meet with a counselor to review course requests.
- > If a student does not have Course Planning form with parent signature, they will not be able to complete the process.
- > Students/parents will receive confirmation of courses after process is completed.



# UC/CSU Entrance Requirements

- 4 years Language Arts
- 2 years Social Studies
- 3 years Math (4 years recommended)
  - > Must include Integrated Math I, II, and III
- 2 years Lab Science (4 years recommended)
  - > Must include one year Physical Science & one year Life Science (Biology/Biomed and Physics or Chemistry required at UC)
- 2 years Foreign Language (3 years recommended)
- 1 year Visual & Performing Arts
- 1 year College Prep Elective from A-G approved list
- SAT Reasoning Test or ACT
- SAT Subject Tests( UC only -Some majors RECOMMEND)



# College Entrance Exams

- PSAT – Practice SAT (October)
- FREE Test Prep through Khan Academy
- Mock SAT/ACT Combo (typically fall/spring)
- SAT Reasoning Test OR ACT (Junior Year)
  - > SAT – [www.collegeboard.org](http://www.collegeboard.org)
  - > ACT – [www.act.org](http://www.act.org)
- SAT Subject Tests – Determine if specific college/major will require.
