

Dear Parent/Guardian,

It is hard to believe we are over a quarter of the way through sophomore year! The quarter ended on Friday, October 13th and the following week quarter grades were issued by teachers. This signifies the halfway point in the current semester which concludes on **Thursday, December 21st**. If your student received a NM (No Mark) in any course at the quarter, please encourage your student to speak with the teacher as soon as possible to discuss their grade and make a plan of action to get back on track. Teachers are always available to provide additional support before/after school and this extra support can be extremely beneficial. We also have free homework help in the College & Career Center in Room H4 Tuesdays through Thursdays from 2:45 – 3:30pm. This is a great environment for students to complete homework and access help if needed. Should you have any questions regarding your student's progress, it is always best to contact the teacher directly for specific information.

Also, as you know all sophomores took the PSAT earlier this month. This provided a great opportunity for students to “practice” the SAT. Students can register to take the PSAT again next fall and will typically take the regular SAT and/or ACT in spring of junior year. Rocklin High School is also offering a Mock SAT/ACT test on **Saturday, November 18th** at 8:00am. This provides a wonderful opportunity for students to have a “sample” of both the SAT and ACT to compare the two tests and determine which test they may likely execute a stronger performance on when they take the actual one next year.

In regards to community service, students are required to complete 25 hours to meet graduation requirements. Students must submit hours during the school year in which the hours are completed. Community Service Contracts are available in the Counseling Center as well as on the RHS website and should be filled out by student with parent and supervisor signature. Contracts can be submitted in the Counseling Center to have hours documented.
