The meeting of Rocklin High School Site Council was called to order at 4:01PM by Juan Sanchez.

Minutes: The minutes of the meeting of October 24, 2017 were passed. Lou Lopez made a motion to approve. Rachelle Sloan seconded the motion. Vote was unanimous to approve the minutes.

Agenda: There were no changes to the agenda. The agenda was approved.

New Business:

School Safety Plan. Mike Pappas oversees school safety. He discussed the lockdown procedure as well as the different stages to happen in the event of an evacuation. Lou Lopez made a motion to approve the school safety plan. Anna Ostrom seconded the motion. Vote was unanimous to approve the school safety plan.

Mike Pappas also went over the results of the California Healthy Kids Survey. This survey was administered to all students in grades 9 and 11 in the fall. Results are posted online on the Rocklin High School website.

Administrative Report: Dave Stewart gave an overview of the WASC report. March 11- March 14, WASC will be on our campus visiting. Mike Pappas and Angela Parker put together a 245 page report and WASC will be here to see if RHS reflects the study they have done. They will be visiting with staff and students.

A-G Compliant: Dave Stewart recently sent out a newsletter to parents stating that RHS is attempting to ensure that every student is College and Career ready. In addition, if a 12th grader is not on track in one of those areas, they will be required to take a full schedule (8 classes).

Class Rank: RHS will eliminate class ranking. RUSD will no longer list a student's class rank on their transcripts. Eliminating class rank reduces pressure and lessens competition and stress.

AP Classes: Dave Stewart stated that he is in the beginning stage of discussing whether or not to cap the number of AP classes that a student can take.

New Classes Offered: There are 2 new classes being offered here at RHS. They are accounting and Service Leadership.
