Transfer Agreement Guarantee (UC's)

- Six University of California (no LA, Berkeley or SD) campuses offer guaranteed admission to students from all California community colleges.
- Interested students must meet campus-specific requirements to qualify for a UC TAG.
- Students submit TAG early fall the year prior to transfer to ONLY one UC and receive notice of acceptance and specific guidance on major preparation and general education coursework by November 15.



Sierra College Admission Process

1. Complete an online application
2. Submit your transcript
3. Create your MySierra account
4. Complete online orientation
5. Take Accuplacer exams (or prove that you don't need to)
6. Schedule a new student counseling session
7. Register for classes
8. Graduate from RHS

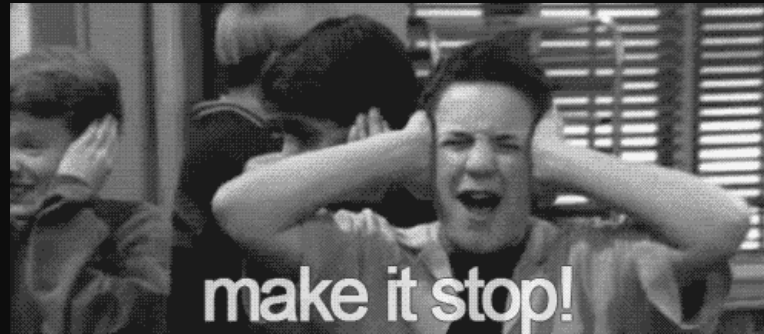

Admission to most colleges is competitive. There are more qualified applicants than there is space for them to attend. No matter how great your application looks, there are no guarantees that you will be admitted!!!

Everyone needs a good back up plan

Application Requirements

CSU's

- Separate application for each campus – but most pages will pre-fill once you have completed one.
- Test Scores must be reported on application and sent from College Board or ACT
- No transcript of letter of recommendation required with application
- No personal statement essay required
- No extra-curricular activities required
- No Early Action or Early Decision except for Cal Poly

Application Requirements


UC's

- One application to complete, then you select which school's receive it.
- Test Scores must be reported on application and sent from College Board or ACT
- No transcript of letter of recommendation required with application
- Personal statement essay required
- Extra-curricular activities required
- No Early Action or Early Decision

Application Requirements

Common App

- One application to complete, then you select which school's receive it
- Transcript required with application as well as at mid-year
- Test Scores must be reported on application and sent from College Board or ACT
- Most schools will require or accept letters of recommendation
- Personal statement essay required
- Extra-curricular activities required
- Many schools require supplemental writing
- May offer Early Action, Early Decision, Priority, etc.

Request Letters of Recommendation

Only if you need them!!!

1. Fill out a Letter of Recommendation Request Form and attach your transcript and Naviance resume:

<http://goo.gl/cswLBJ>

2. Hand deliver the request and ask your teacher if they are willing to write a letter for you WELL BEFORE YOUR DEADLINE. Have a conversation with them about and theme or focus you would like the letter to have.

3. If you are using Common App, you will need to invite your teacher to submit a recommendation by entering their email address in the application.
MAKE SURE YOU HAVE THEIR ADDRESS CORRECT.

4. Common App gives your counselor an option of writing a letter for you. If you would like Mrs. Harris to write one, please follow the same process as asking a teacher.

To send to multiple CSU's:

SAT: Send to code **3594**.

All campuses will access them there. When you select this code, it may show an address in long beach. That is okay.

ACT: Send to any one university to which you are applying then use the ACT score manager within CSU Mentor to share with all others.

To send to multiple UC's:

SAT & ACT: Send to any one UC, the others will be able to access it.

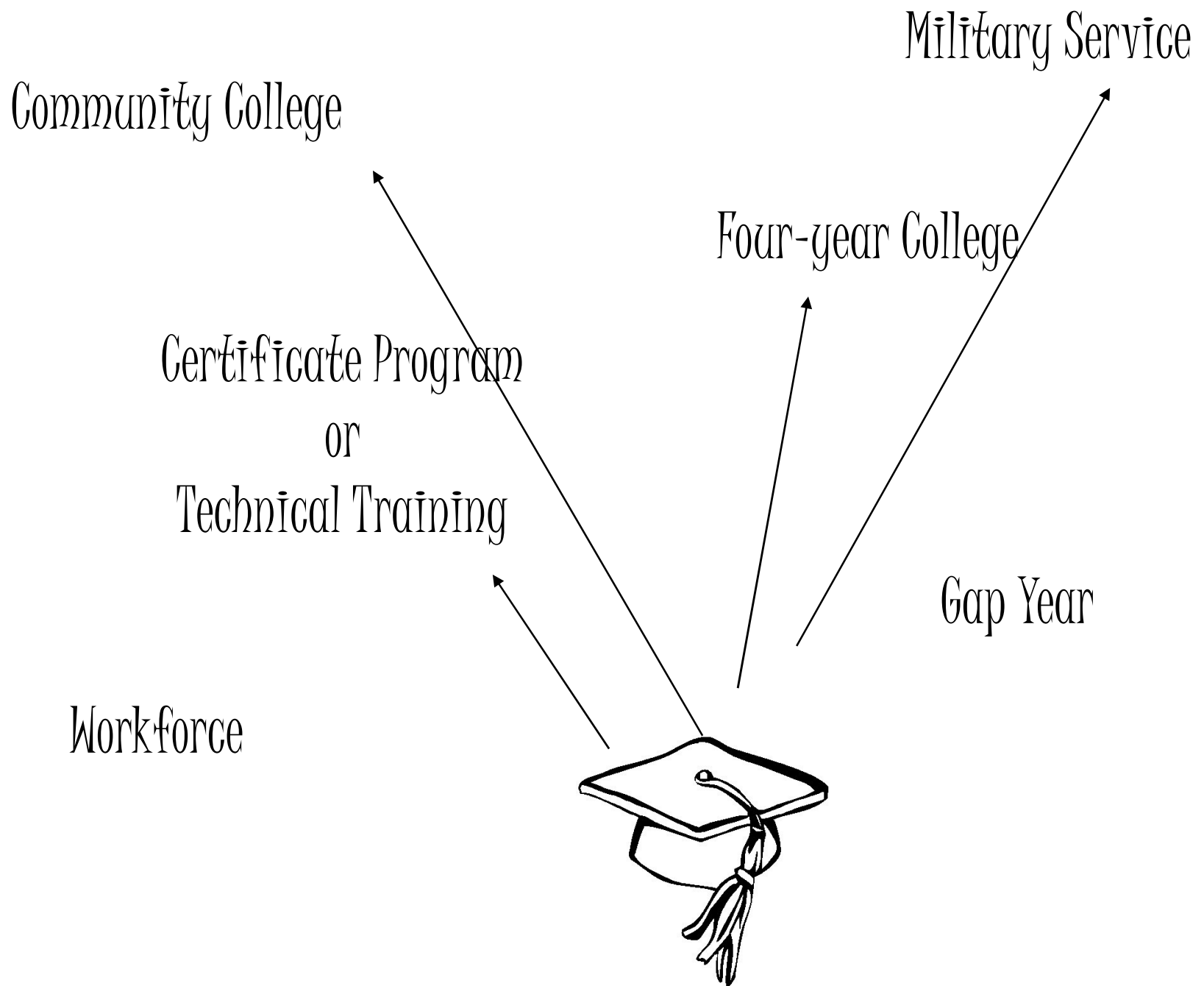

- **Assist-a-grad!!!**



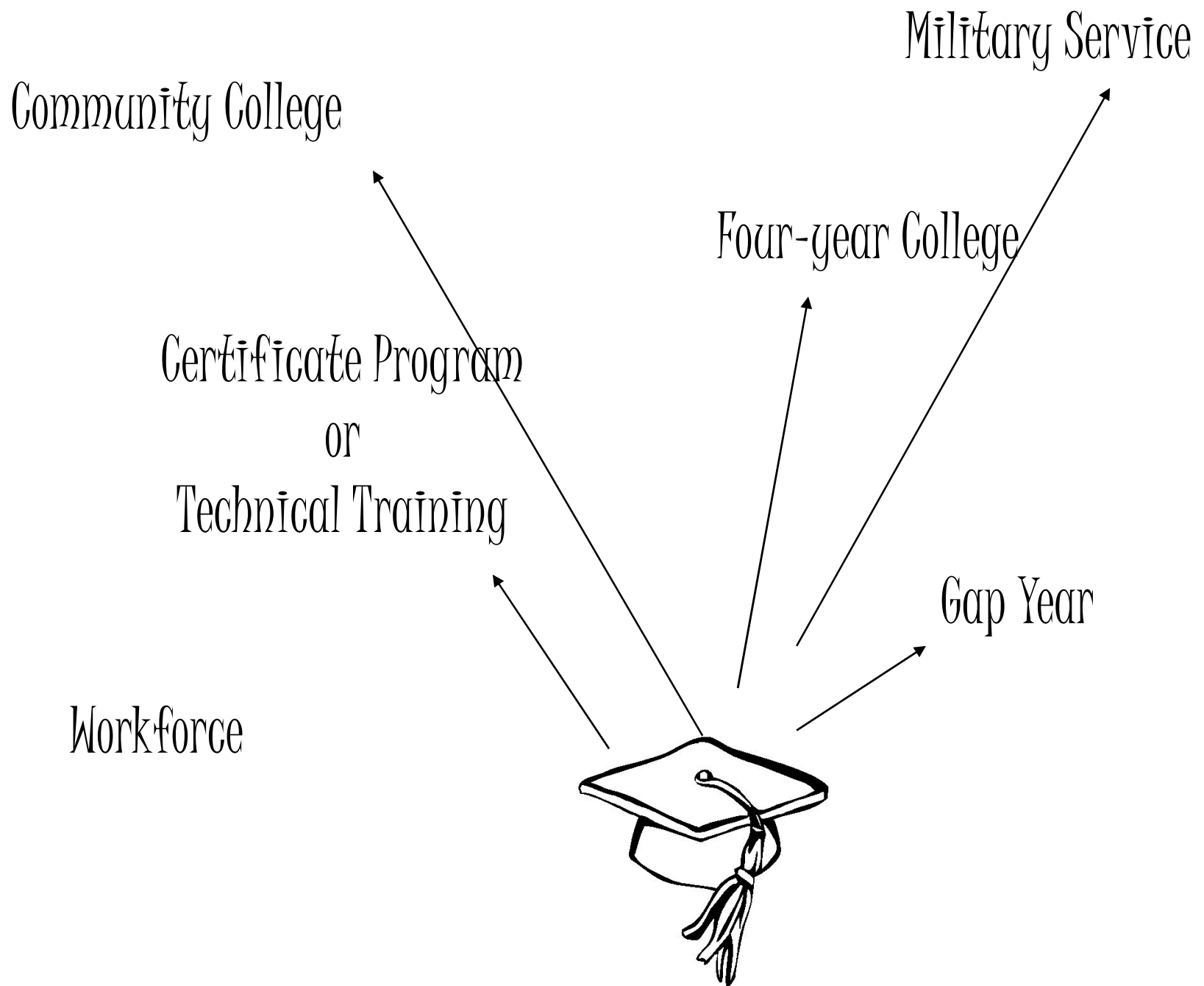

What is it? – Time off of schoolwork before beginning college.

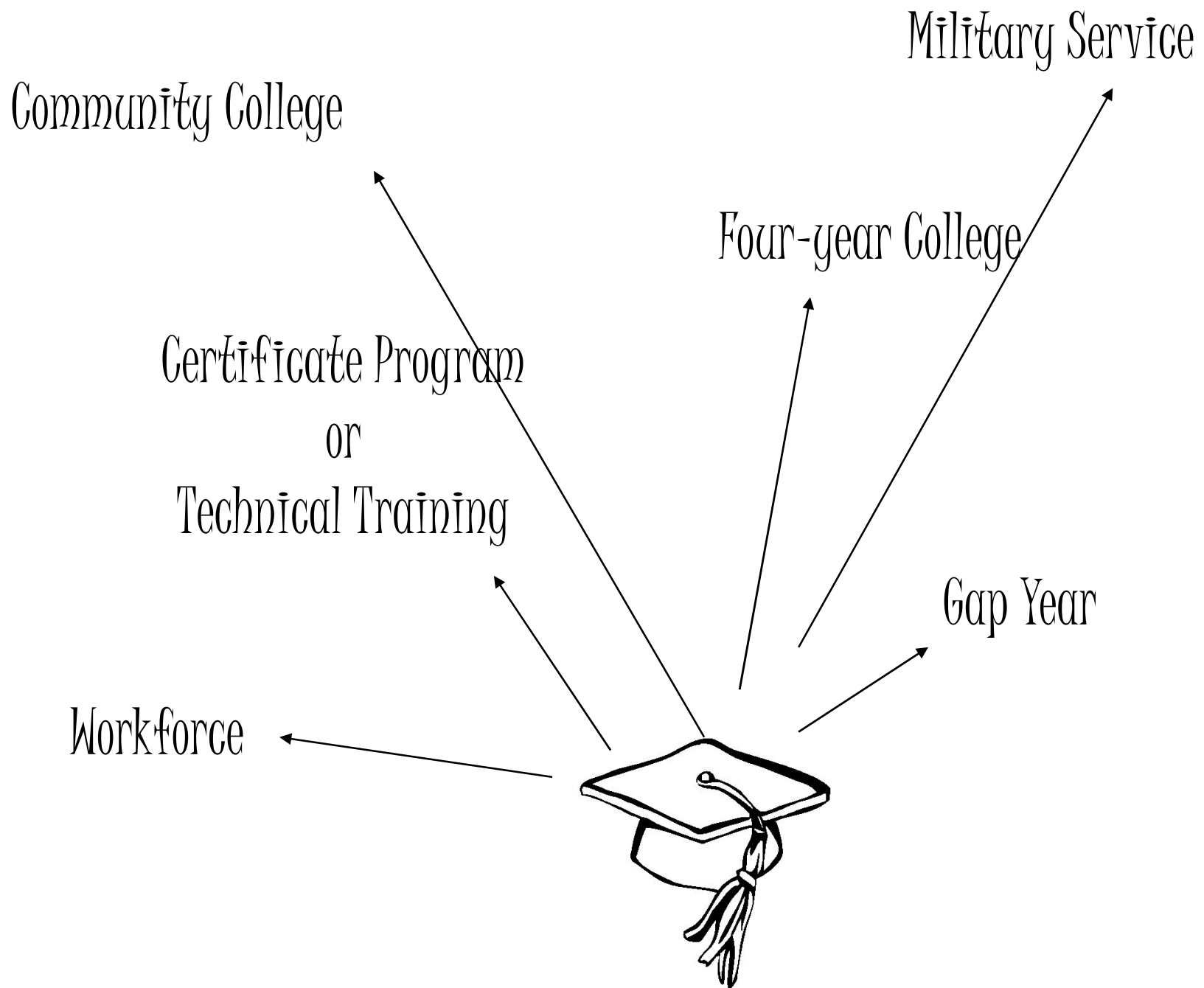
What is it not? – Time to sit on the couch and mooch off your parents.

Tips

- Apply to colleges your senior year
 - This gives you options if your gap year plans do not materialize.
 - You become familiar with the application process while you have the support of your high school staff.
 - You may be able to defer acceptances.
- Structure your time. Have a plan.
 - Work, travel, internships, community service, cultural exchange
 - If your plan includes time away from home, think about doing that part in the fall.

Students who take gap years report feeling more motivated, responsible, and independent. They tend to be more fiscally aware than most college students and feel a greater sense of educational purpose once they return to the university setting.



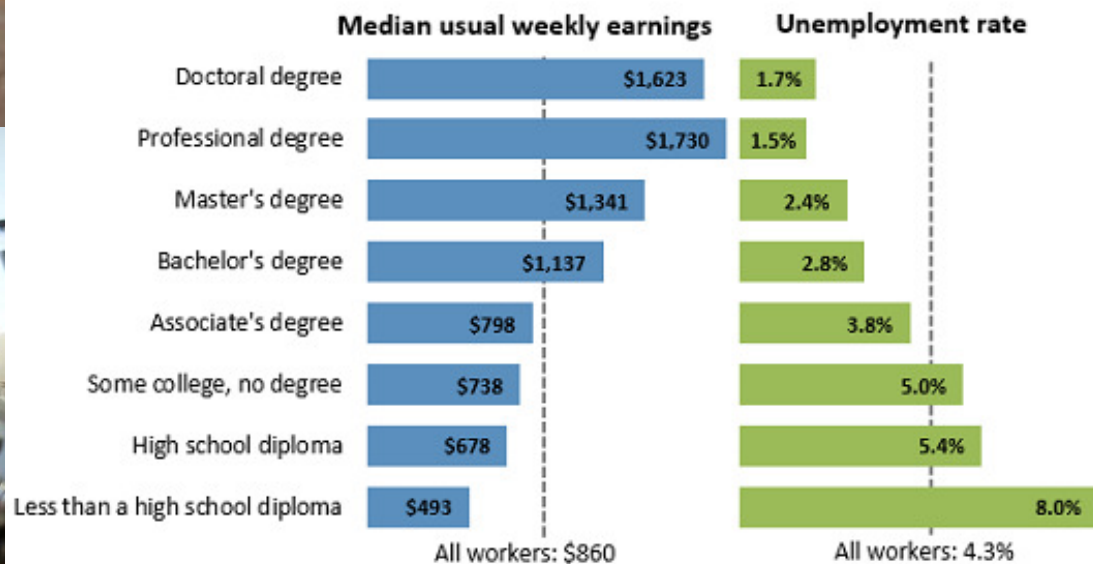
Entering the Workforce After High School

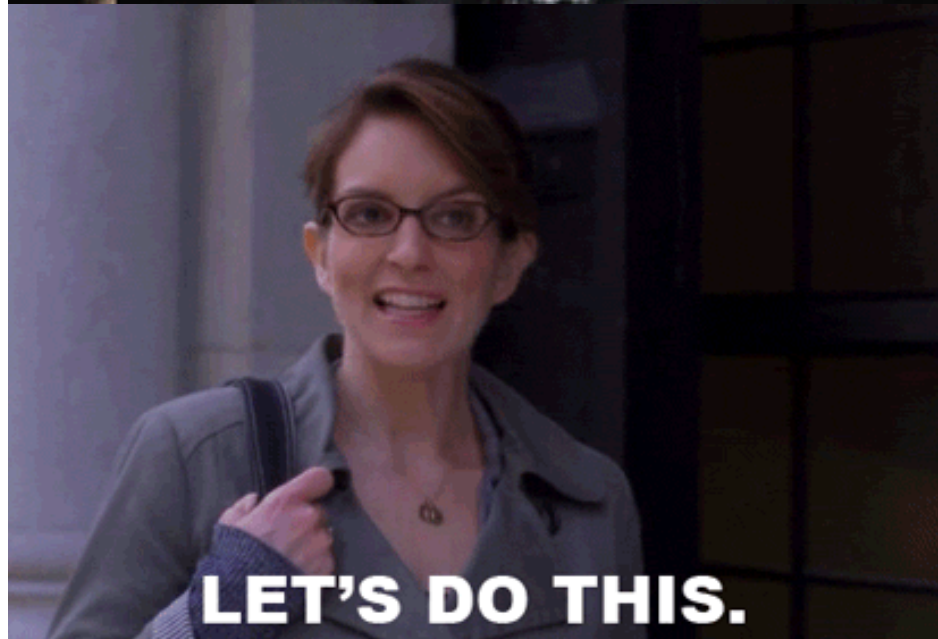
