Time Commitment: One year, including at least 3 events and 4 programs - 20 hours per year (about 2 hours per month)

Duties: Taking place mainly on Fridays, weekends, or during school breaks

#### **Events:**

- Lead crafts
- Answer questions about the Museum, the history of the Nisenan, and the Museum's mission
- Present activities in the museum and on the trail
- Guide traffic
- Help set up and clean up

#### Classes:

- Assist staff leader
- Redirection of behavior
- Assist with set up and clean up

## **Additional Opportunity:**

- During Museum open hours
- Choose a spot in the museum or on the trail
- Lead an activity, answer questions, help direct traffic
- For as much time as available

#### Qualifications:

- At least 15 years old ability to get transportation to and from the Museum
- Ability and desire to work with people of all ages and backgrounds
- Be able to say 'I don't know' when the time calls for it and ask for assistance in answering questions

### Training:

- Attend 1 Saturday training
- Shadow 1 event and 1 class
