How to Set Up Your Diorama

Directions:

You will need construction paper, tape or glue, and the copies of diorama maps and questions.

- 1. Fold each sheet of construction paper into four parts and then unfold to a flat position (see figure i and ii).
- 2. Cut along the highlighted fold as shown in figure iii (make sure you cut along the shortest fold).
- 3. Stand quadrants C and D up so they are perpendicular to quadrants A and B (see figure iv).
- 4. Pull corner A over the shaded quadrant to point B, so that A now overlaps B (notice the arrow in figure v). The paper will now become a three-sided display platform. Your paper should now look like figure vi.
- Then tape or glue section A to section B to secure your 3-D platform. Repeat the process for the other three
- 6. When all four displays are completed, put them together, back-to-back and tape or glue (see figure vii).
