

STEM CHANGING VERBS or Boot/shoe Verbs

Reminder: The infinitive is the base form of the verb. Spanish verbs end in –ar, -er or –ir. When the endings are removed that which remains is called the **stem**. This handout introduces **stem-changing verbs**.

Stem-changing verbs that end in “-ar” , “-er” or “-ir” change the stem vowel in the present tense in four possible ways: **e>ie** , **e>i**, **o>ue** and **u> ue** in all forms **except nosotros** . The conjugations that stem change form a boot or a shoe [except the nosotros conjugation because[“we”got kicked out].

a.) Examples of e>ie:

pensar – to think	
pienso	<i>pensamos</i>
piensas	x
piensa	piensan

querer – to want, love	
quiero	<i>queremos</i>
quieres	x
quiere	quieren

Some common “e>ie”:

Empezar a – to begin
Comenzar a – to start
Preferir – to prefer
Perder- to lose

Recomendar – to recommend
Entender – to understand
Nevar - to snow
Sentar (se) – to seat, sit down
Cerrar – to close

b.) Examples of e>i:

pedir – to ask for; request	
pido	<i>pedimos</i>
pides	x
pide	piden

Some common “-ir” verbs that pattern “e>i”:

Servir- to serve
Vestir(se) – to dress

c.) Examples of o>ue:

volver – to return	
vuelvo	<i>volvemos</i>
vuelves	x
vuelve	vuelven

dormir- to sleep	
duermo	<i>dormimos</i>
duermes	x
duerme	duermen

Some common verbs“-ar” and “-er” verbs that pattern “o>ue” (two exceptions noted):

Poder- to be able to [can]
Morir- to die
Almorzar – to eat lunch

Costar – to cost
Volver – to return, give back

d.) Example of u>ue:

jugar- to play [sports or board games]	
juego	<i>jugamos</i>
juegas	x
juega	juegan
